His journey in Washington State will consist of 20 days of travel, including WA State Route 203, US Route 2 in Washington and WA State Route 290, with stops in Klahanie, Monroe, Baring, Scenic, Stevens Pass, Winton, Leavenworth, Monitor, Orondo, Farmer, Coulee City, Almira, Creston, Davenport, Airway Heights & Newman Lake, and continuing into Idaho, North Dakota, South Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Maryland, and Delaware. He plans to travel over 3 thousand miles, crossing 12 states in 6 months and ending his journey in Delaware in October 2016.

Previously, Janusz has completed a wheelchair marathon from Rome, Italy to Wadowice, Poland in 2015. His 'super-marathon' in the United States is a challenge with enormous proportion and he is determined to succeed.
